Working from home:

- Do your remote workers have access to a first aid kit?
- Do you know the best phone # to reach them? Many people do not have a land line!
- Are there any specific hazards? Potential flooding, landslide, wildfire...
- ✓ Are your workers keeping their exits clear? Yes, there is a story hear...☺
- Can you do a virtual safety walk through? Use a phone camera, have you worker tour you through their workspace.
- ✓ Have you considered ergonomics? Sofa + Laptop = Back issues!
- Remember, your workers may be working alone! Have a method to do periodic check-ins.



Some hot topics that have come up so far:

- Audience spacing and movement
- ✓ FOH exposure control plans
- Washroom use
- ✓ Physical Distancing for performance groups
- Equipment Sanitation
- ✓ PPE
- ✓ Box office exposure control plans
- Communicating any of these to clients



Sound Check? Physical distancing?

- Schedule: Set-up time with out performers in the room.
- Allow one band member at a time to set-up. Leave plenty of time for the drummer (Insert joke hear).
- One tech on stage only.
- Tape out the stage tech work area (monitor desk?) DO NOT ENTER!
- Use wireless tech for monitor set-up.
- Musicians strike and leave BEFORE the tech strikes the stage!



WWDD?

- Run scenarios for your organization
- Run scenarios at similar crowd sizes to the shut-down
- Ask your workers and clients what they are doing to lower the risk of COVID-19
- Review your current safety program for gaps
