Updates!

In the now, what's happening:

- Sept classes, in person at various post secondary locations
- AIP Week Sept 20 – 24. PA day Wed Sept 22, Granville Island, WWDD on location special!
- Inspections course in next review by the working group.
- Road trip planning pushed to mid October. Oct 18 – 26?
- Interior restrictions.
- Vaccine passport/card... What are they thinking?
- Mask Mandate? We all up to speed?

I'm not even sure where to start. The industry is thoroughly confused and upset by the recent announcements. Actsafe is in the same boat. The industry has brought many concerns to us and I will pass them along here.

- Please stop making policy announcements late Friday afternoons! This is incredibly difficult for an industry that works primarily Friday - Sunday.
- Stop sliding announcements into other updates. Today's mask announcement during the education update was absolutely infuriating (not my words).
- Making the announcements without the written order to back it up is unfair. Not once has the written order matched the information in the media update and we as the health and safety association are left with no written back-up to the orders. Often for days.
- There is confusion around the "consultation" that has apparently taken place prior to the vaccine card announcement. Could you please clarify who was consulted? I have found no one in any of our groups (as of 13:28 Tuesday) that was contacted prior to Monday. And as a heads-up, most industry stakeholders consider consultation to be a two-way communication. Not an announcement the morning of the update. While we respect the actions being taken to protect our province, the credibility of the message is being compromised by the above issues, making it difficult to help spread the message, and even more difficult for people to buy-in.

Updates:

- Communicable Disease Plan template is live on our website.
- 4 CDP so far.
- 11 calls Saturday from interior groups blindsided by Fridays announcement.

Outreach in the last 7 days:

- 3 video calls
- 105 attendees.

The Message:

- Regardless of what WorkSafe says about not requiring a written "Communicable Disease Plan", we HIGHLY recommend you create one and have it on hand in case of a WorkSafe or Health authority visit.
- WorkSafe is not clarifying the employers role in the vaccine card program.
- Use your best judgement, there will be no clarity for productions.
