## Your Right to Refuse

## UNSAFE WORK

You are required to refuse work that you believe is likely to harm you or someone else.

\*Report any health and safety issues to your supervisor or employer.

★ They must immediately investigate and fix the problem

or inform you if they don't think that there is a problem.

★ If you still believe there is a problem, continue to refuse work. The supervisor is required to continue to investigate with you and another worker (from the H & S Committee, the union, or a person of your choice).

★ If there is no resolution, continue to refuse the work. Both you and the employer must contact WorkSafeBC for further investigation.

You cannot be fired for refusing unsafe work.
