WHY DO YOU NEED AN AED?

When an AED and CPR are immediately available, the chance of survival from sudden cardiac arrest is substantially improved. Combined with CPR, the use of an AED may increase the likelihood of survival by 75% or more.

For every one minute delay in defibrillation, the survival rate of a cardiac arrest victim decreases by 7 to 10%. After more than 12 minutes of ventricular fibrillation, the survival rate is less than 5%. AEDs combined with CPR and activating emergency medical services offer the best chance of saving a life in the event of a cardiac arrest.

Research shows that AEDs are most effectively used by trained individuals. However, AEDs are safe and easy to use by almost anyone. In fact, there are studies showing that laypersons can use AEDs safely and effectively. There are also examples of cases where individuals with no training have successfully used an AED in an emergency situation as they are very straightforward to use and self-guiding.

Legislation in provinces across Canada protects individuals who use AEDs from liability when they are used in the context of saving a life.

Anybody can use an AED machine however all levels of occupational first aid training include instruction on the care and use of AEDs. An additional orientation can be achieved by having workers view the short 20 minute orientation and training video that is included with every Medtronic LIFEPAK CR Plus defibrillator.
